Begin to control frustration

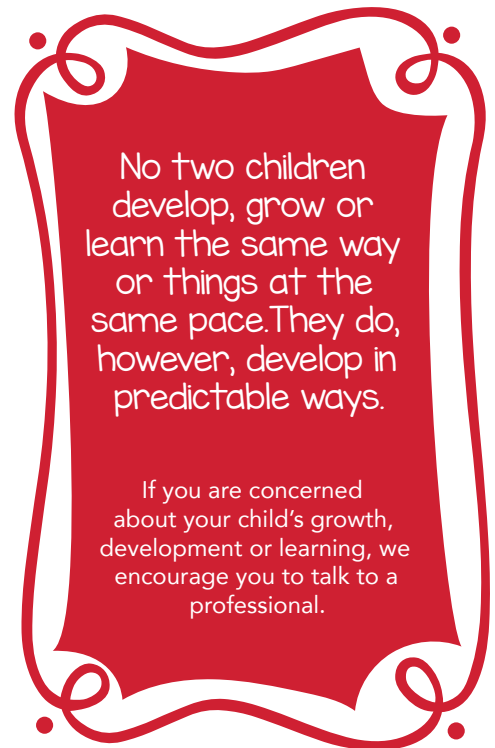
Identify and name common shapes

- Let me make meaningful choices every day
- Pay attention to me when I am talking
- Give me opportunities to play with other children
- Encourage me to try new things and solve problems
- Provide me with a warm loving relationship
- Model positive ways to interact with others
- Ask questions that encourage me to think about what I see and hear
- Point out signs and names of things
- Use mealtime and other daily routines as an opportunity for conversation
- Make physical activity part of everyday
- Repeat nursery rhymes and play word games with me
- Provide me with writing materials, markers, pencils, and paper
