CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY PRIOR TO START DATE

If you withdraw from a class 1 week or more before the start date, you will receive a refund minus a \$5.00 processing fee.
 If you withdraw from a class less than 1 week before the start date, you will receive a pro-rated refund minus any costs incurred, including a \$5.00 processing fee.
No refunds 72 hours prior to class start date.

CLASS WITHDRAWAL POLICY AFTER START DATE

You may withdraw from classes of three sessions or more after attending the first session. You must notify the Enrichment Office, 328-4000 of your intent to withdraw prior to the second class. Unless otherwise indicated you will be issued a prorated refund minus a \$5 processing fee and any costs incurred.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents are responsible for their student’s transportation unless noted otherwise. When picking up your student from class, please be prompt, as additional supervision is not provided after class.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Families who qualify for the free or reduced price meal program may receive a 50 percent reduction in class fees up to \$25 per child, per brochure.
