CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY PRIOR TO START DATE

Class cancellation must be made a minimum of one week prior to the class starting date for a full refund (unless otherwise noted). If you cancel with less than a week notice, prior to the first class, you will be issued a refund minus a \$5 processing fee and any costs incurred (including supplies, food, and salaries). **No refunds 72 hours prior to class start date.**

CLASS WITHDRAWAL POLICY AFTER START DATE

You may withdraw from classes of three sessions or more after attending the first session. You must notify the Enrichment Office, 328-4000 of your intent to withdraw prior to the second class. Unless otherwise indicated you will be issued a prorated refund minus a \$5 processing fee and any costs incurred.
